**Keywords:** distance learning, ahaslides, quiz, presentation, relay, prezi, ludus, video recording.

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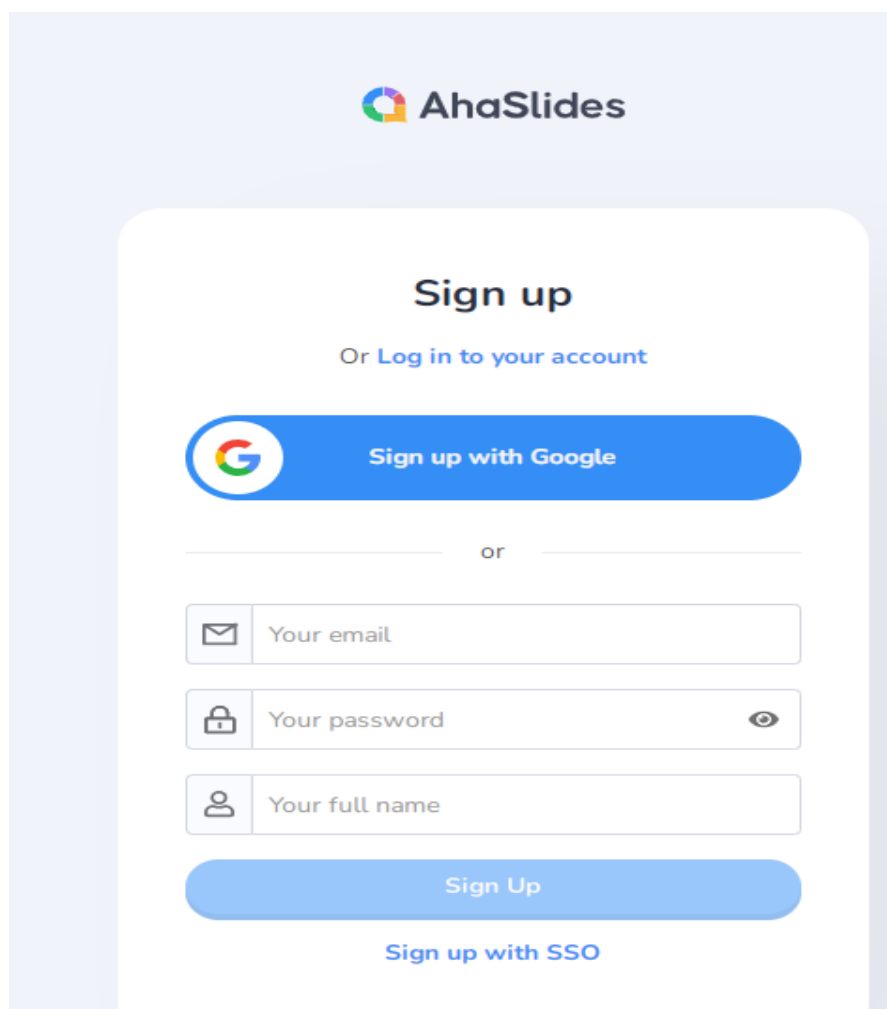
## 1. INTRODUCTION

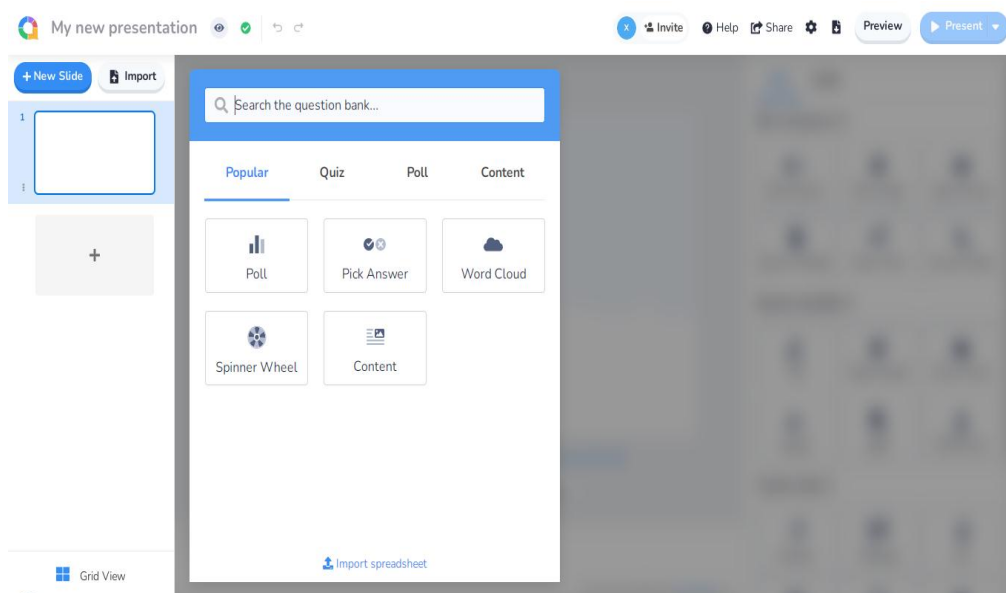
The program we want to tell you about is called Ahaslides. When we enter the program, we need to register and the following window will open.

**Figure 2. Presentation window of the program.**

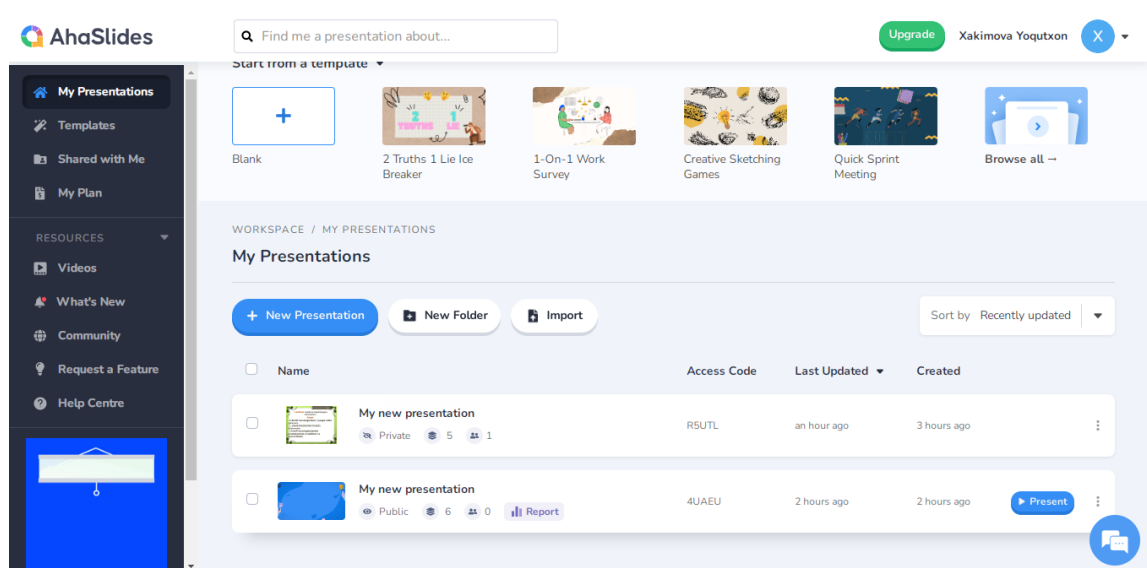
