It was not generally seen on the public stage until the 20th century. The dance movements are characterized by fraudulent legs, while bases keep cadence. Hands may be used in a series of mudras, or representational hand gestures, to tell a story. Bharatanatyam, a pre-eminent Indian classical dance form presumably the oldest classical dance heritage of India is regarded as the ma of multitudinous other Indian classical dance forms. Conventionally a solo dance performed only by women, it was initiated in the Hindu temples of Tamil Nadu and eventually flourished in South India. The theoretical base of this form traces back to 'Natya Shastra', the ancient Sanskrit Hindu text on the performing trades. A form of exegetical yarn of Hindu religious themes and spiritual ideas toadied by hop with excellent footwork and emotional gestures its performance force includes nritta, nritya, and Natya. A vocalist, musicians, and especially the guru who oversees and conducts the performance all serve as accompanists.. It also continues to inspire several art forms including canvases and dollies starting from the spectacular 6th to 9th century CE temple dollies.

FOLK DANCE: Folk Cotillion, generally, is a type of dance that is generally recreational, an expression of a history or present culture. Until the middle of the 20th century, the name "folk dance" was acceptable.. A folk dance is one that depicts the way of life of the citizens of a certain nation or territory. FREESTYLE DANCE: Freestyle dance is the complete movement improvisation of a dancer. Dancers do not plan or choreograph their movements in advance, and there are no routine exercises. All movements are decided intuitively and instantly, which creates an original dance experience. Freestyle is an inventive and creative dance style. It is a unique and artistic form of self-expression and dance that allows the dancer to organically respond to their emotions and the tone of the music. While individual dance moves can be practiced in advance, or years of dance practice can help develop a dancer's skills in a particular genre, freestyle dance allows a dancer to use a combined knowledge of dance genres to create a unique set of moves for a routine. . . Freestyle dance is not usually a scheduled class in a dance studio, but is often taught in other people's classes. , Teachers can allow dancers to freestyle and practice

the dance style they are teaching in that class. They can give their dancers the opportunity to jam or freestyle throughout the song, or ask them to improvise opening credits before the choreography they're teaching begins. Although it is a dance style strongly rooted in pop culture, not all dancers are good at freestyle. Talented freestyle dancers often showcase their skills in all media, including television commercials, music videos and movies.
